

Breadcrumb added in two ways in divi –

Note: It requires Yoast SEO plugin

1) Website in which header created with divi builders global header
Like in MBN (Header created with groovy menu plugin which is globally)

2) Website in which using normal header (without divi builders) Like OIT

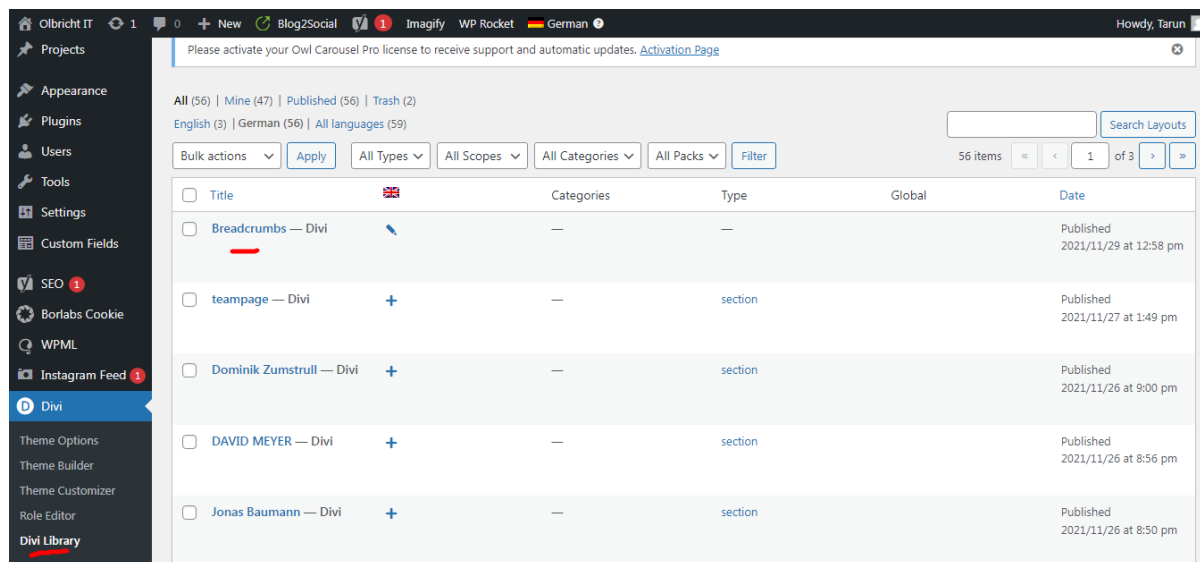
Case 1

In global header we can directly add this shortcode to show breadcrumbs:

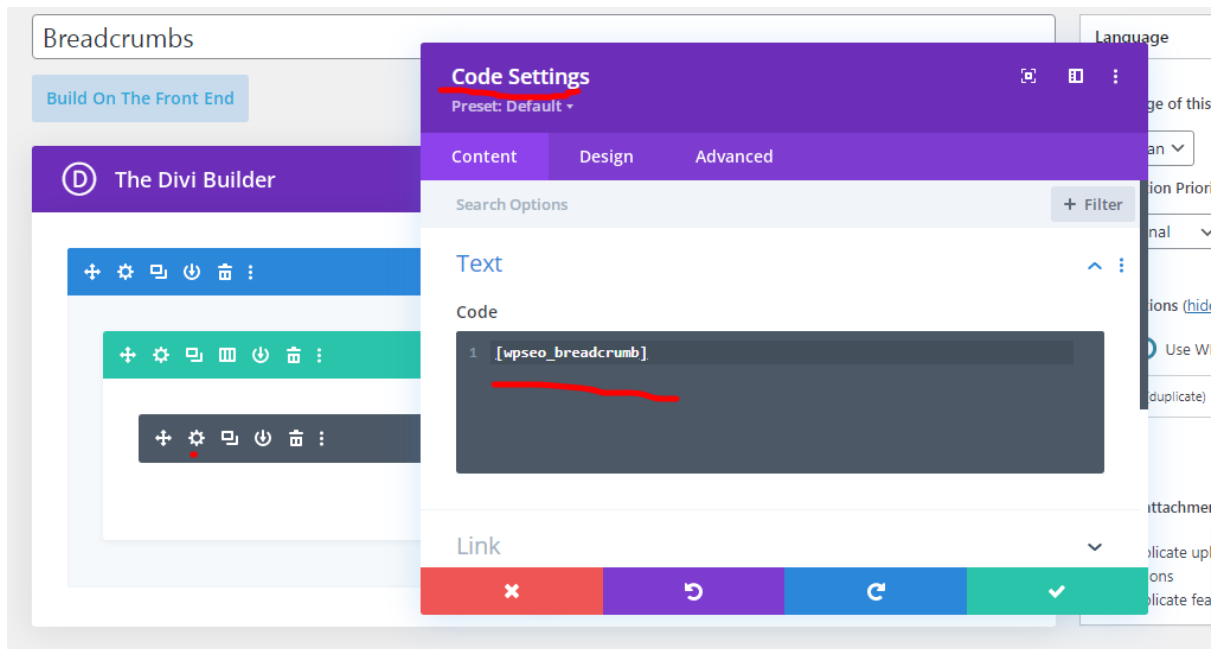
[wpseo_breadcrumb]

Case 2 : For normal header

i) Create a layout in “Divi Library”



ii) After adding new layout, Create a section in it and add code module and placed shortcode in it
[wpseo_breadcrumb]

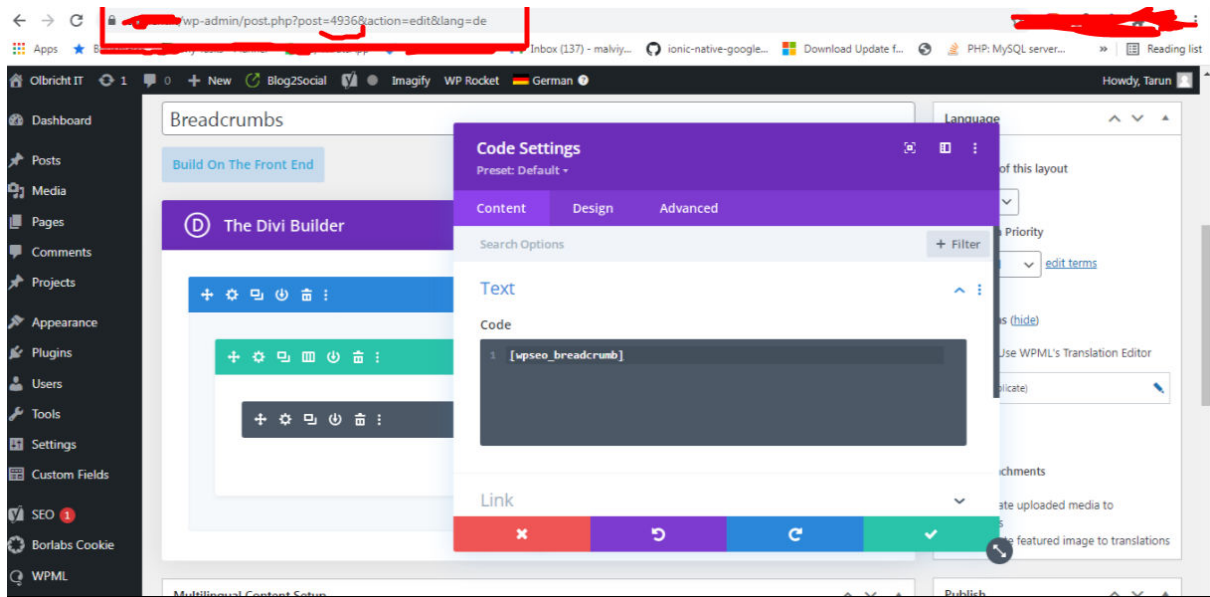


Then save it.

iii) Add this php code in child themes functions.php file

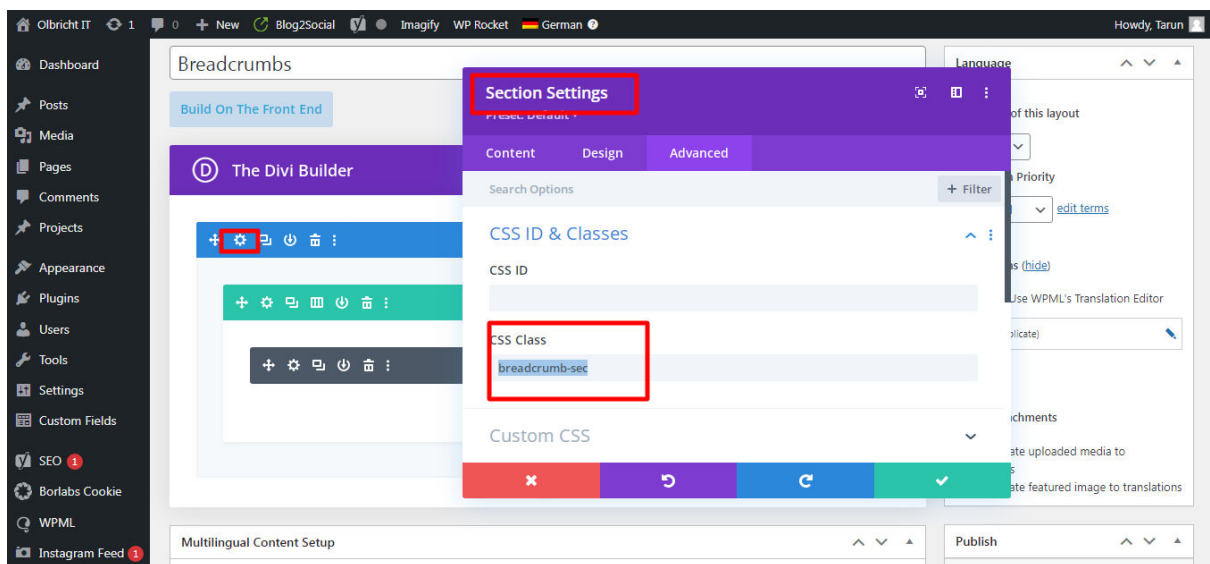

To hide breadcrumb on particular pages

To hide it on particular page, we can add a class name “breadcrumb-sec” on section like:



Then add this css with page id so it will hide on that page only

```
.page-id-50 .et_pb_section.breadcrumb-sec {  
    display: none;  
}
```

Also decrease space on top bottom we have to add
